#### **ABOUT THE ARTHUR "PAPPY" KENNEDY SCHOLARSHIP**

In 1973 Arthur "Pappy" Kennedy changed the course of local history when he was elected to the Orlando City Council. As the first Black elected official, he not only set a precedent in Orlando politics, but also a standard for living and unity. Pappy's governmental influence affected the building of Hankins Park, the landscaping of Parramore Street, and the organization of the Orlando Negro Chamber of Commerce. His influence in the community was felt through Meals on Wheels, the United Negro College Fund, the NAACP, and his advocacy for the poor.

The YMCA of Central Florida and the Southwest Orlando Jaycees will award a **\$1,500** Arthur Pappy Kennedy Scholarship to a deserving minority high school student in an effort to assist with post-secondary educational pursuits and cost of books. Recipients must be available for award presentation.

Outstanding minority high school students are encouraged to apply who plans to matriculate at a postsecondary institution by Fall 2021. Applicants must be in good academic standing, demonstrate strong leadership and community service.

#### **PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship is designed to assist minority high school seniors who are academically motivated and plan to matriculate into an accredited post-secondary institution of their choice in the Fall of 2021, but may lack the finances to cover all of the cost associated with attendance and/or books.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

For scholarship eligibility, students **must** fulfill the following requirements:

- Completed scholarship application by February 15<sup>th</sup>
- Participation in school leadership activities and/or extra-curricular programs
- Strong volunteer/charitable service record
- Overall G.P.A. of 2.5 or better (copy of current transcript or report card required)
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from either of the following:
  - High School Counselor (submitted on high school letterhead)
  - ♦ Teacher (submitted on high school letterhead)
  - ♦ Church Leader
  - Mentor
- 500-750 word typed essay (essay instructions attached)



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#### SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AND NOTIFICATION

The YMCA of Central Florida and the Southwest Orlando Jaycees will award scholarships to a selected student. The student will be selected on the basis of academic performance, quality of their essay, volunteer/charitable service record and participation in school leadership and/or extra-curricular programs. All essays will be reviewed by the Arthur Pappy Kennedy Scholarship Committee.

Application Deadline:February 15, 2021Scholarship Award Notification:March 5, 2021

If awarded, the scholarship(s) will be disbursed no later than **October 2021** after receiving verification documentation that students are enrolled into their college/university of choice.

Handwritten applications will not be accepted. All qualified scholarship applications must be typed for consideration. In addition, two Letter of Recommendation Certification forms must be submitted, as well as two letters of recommendation should be attached along with your application.
